



EuFood-STA at the University Business Forum, 25-26 February 2016, Vienna, Austria

Jointly organised by the European Commission, the Austrian Federal Economic Chamber and the Austrian Federal Ministry of Science, the University Business Forum in Vienna, Austria, from 25-26 February 2016, brought together more than 500 participants discussing cooperation between business and universities as a driver for innovation.

The **Food-STA project** was presented together with a number of other Knowledge Alliances in the Knowledge Alliance Showroom where representatives from the project Gerhard Schleining, Rainer Svacinka and Line Friis Lindner (BOKU) displayed the Food-STA poster and handed out leaflets about the project to participants of the University Business Forum.

During the conference, participants were offered the opportunity to participate in one of four parallel sessions focusing on **dual study programmes** as a model for better matching the competences of graduates and the requirements of employers; ways in which **HE institutions can create entrepreneurial spirit** among researchers, educators, company staff and students through interdisciplinary teaching; the multi-faceted **role of HE institutions** in dealing with such innovative initiatives; and how collaborations between business and education providers can help ensure relevant and **high-quality lifelong learning** provision.
